Unifying Strategies/Scorecard

Make Disciples

By discovering and practicing a reproducible model of making disciples, I can train others to make an impact for Christ and experience the joy that comes from living on mission.

Scorecard:

- Dream, study, pray about what a disciple is and write a simple plan to produce them (as an individual and through a church).
- Consistently disciple 3-5 men over 3-6 month periods and challenge them to disciple others.
- Serve at a church where I can assist in developing a clear strategy and process for multiplying disciples.

- Share creative and relevant disciplemaking strategies with other pastors and churches.
- Live on mission and model a missional life for others.

o Maximize Holistic Health

By developing and growing in spiritual, physical, relational, and financial health, I can lead others to live a life primed for purposeful vitality, wisdom, and meaningful relationships.

Scorecard:

- Spiritual: Read my Bible, pray, and journal each day. Share with others what God is doing in my life.
- Physical: Discover reproducible strategies for eating and exercise that are simple, healthy, and affordable and can be used to help busy people be healthy and deal with stress. Maintain ideal weight.
- Relational: Present my wife to Jesus as better for each day she was with me. Love my kids into their God-given identity and purpose. Make life-giving friendships.
- Financial: Eliminate debt, develop sufficient income streams, and save for the future.
- Establish a 24/6 lifestyle, complete with meaningful Sabbath patterns.

Develop Skills

By continually reading, networking, and connecting with learning environments, I can learn principles and grow in skills that will improve my leadership and help me propel others to greater impact.

Scorecard:

- Learn my own Secret Name and be certified to lead others through the process of discovering their God-given identity.
- Author my own OPUS and Core and be certified to lead others through the process of discovering their God-given purpose.
- Complete Transformational Church consultant training to assist pastors and churches to increase in missional effectiveness.
- Complete 3DM training and begin a reproducing discipleship group.
- Research, choose, and be trained and certified in a model of Life Coaching.

o Create Content

By developing virtual and physical environments, I can develop pathways through which I can introduce 3D people to tools and experiences that will create joy by awakening their souls.

Scorecard:

- Develop a retreat plan (and possibly a center or B/B) where pastors and others can get away with the purpose of working through pain to find their identity, purpose, and mission.
- Create a website and blog where I can write and post content that will encourage diverse segments of 3D people: Pastors, parents, spouses, believers- disciplemakers- to live their Jesus' centered identity, live their purpose, and be on mission.
- Develop unique content for workshops, cohorts, or written resources that equip people to discover their identity, purpose, and mission.
- Develop a coaching philosophy and style where I can inspire others to be disciplemakers, discover their identity in Christ, learn their purpose, and live on mission.

o **Expand Influence**

By making connections through networking and virtual environments, I will gain opportunities to impact 3D people and pastors and churches.

Scorecard:

- Establish a non-profit organization to receive funds for services rendered.
- Create a website, blog, LinkedIn profile, and Facebook group(s) that engage 3D people with tools to help them move from discouraged, disengaged, and distracted to having joy, fulfillment, and focus. Include a special focus area for pastors.
- Market to pastors for their personal 3D impact and to expose them to resources that target the health of their church.
- Market to churches for consulting, leadership training, and to impact 3D people.
- Market to 3D individuals trough blogs, Facebook, and unique content that help people find joy in parenting, marriage, making disciples, and loving on mission.
